Infection Control, Dental Practice Act, OSHA Compliance with Leslie Canham, CDA, RDA Friday, January 26, 2018

SEMINAR SYNOPSIS: Infection Control – How to meet the California Standards: This seminar focuses on the California minimum infection control standards Section 1005 as required for dental license renewal. The participant will be able to determine if their current infection control procedures meet CA regulations infection control and will be provided resources for infection control training and information.

California Dental Practice Act: This seminar will cover the California Dental Practice Act, Rules & Regulations, and Duties & Settings issued by the California Board of Dental Examiners.

Got OSHA? The participant will be able to: 1. Identify the specific safety plans required by OSHA; 2. Understand the basic elements of a blood borne pathogen program; 3. Set up an exposure control incident plan and 4. Understand what recordkeeping forms are required.
